Students need to have a 3.0 grade point average and a college entrance exam score that meets the requirements. Check out the information on the HCC web site. - ◆ The Stanford Achievement Testing for grades K-5 through 9 is April 20 -23. Please make sure that your student is present the week of the testing. A good night's sleep and a healthy breakfast will also help their performance on the test.
- ◆ Students enrolled in the AP classes offered either at Bayshore Christian School or through Florida Virtual School, will be taking their AP exams on May 13 and 14. Exams will be May 13, English Language and Composition from 8-12 and Art History from 12-4. May 14, Macroeconomics from 8-12 and Microeconomics from 12-4 will be given.
